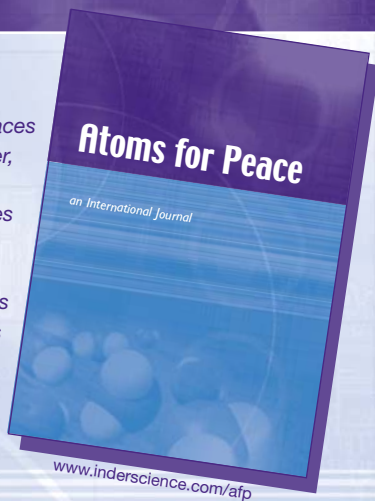
Scope of the Journal
