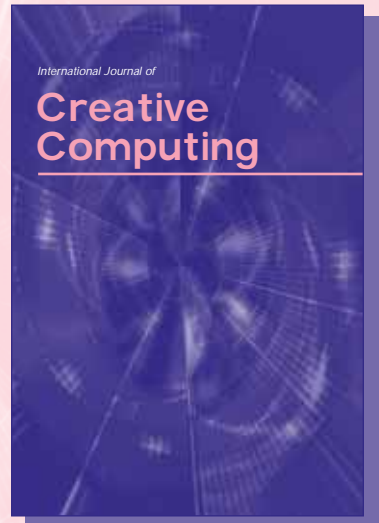
# Scope of the Journal
