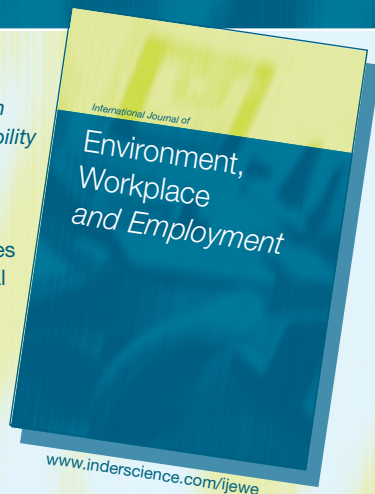
IJEWE provides a refereed international forum for discussion and analysis of the effect that achieving ecological sustainability in the workplace will have on the natural environment.
