The papers would be open access; authors of accepted papers must therefore pay a publication fee after their papers are accepted (see

Special issues should be niche and based on current research problems that have industrial applicability. Special issues can be proposed by scientists and industrial practitioners in collaboration with leading faculties across various leading universities.

Special issues should meet the following conditions:

- 1. They should be niche and innovative.
- 2. They must have industrial applicability.
- 3. Lengthy articles, short articles, datasets and negative results are welcome.
- 4. Reviews should be carried out by three reviewers: two from industries/research institutions and one from a university. All reviewers must have a PhD and good working experience.
- 5. The Guest Editors must agree the journal's publishing policy and timeline managed by the journal's Editors and editorial team. This means that all accepted issues (regular and special issues) that are ready for publishing are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.

How to submit special issue proposals

- 1. Prepare the special issue proposal with the following headings (only suggestions, you can add additional information): Introduction; Applications; Strategy to attract papers; Division of papers (industries vs universities vs research institutions); Reviewer list (tentative); How proposal is innovative and niche; Type of articles invited (long, short, empirical, datasets, negative results, etc); Tentative guest editorial team list (with short and full CVs included).
